

New Dock for Morgan Lake

The Four Corners Junior Bassmasters with support from local companies built and installed a new dock on Morgan Lake on November 1, 2009. The old dock had deteriorated over time and was becoming a safety hazard, the call for action was answered by the junior bassmasters and their parent club the Four Corners Bassmasters.

Lobo Oilfield Service donated the base materials for the construction of the dock, tires to line the dock were donated by Aztec Car Care. Monty Striegel with S & S Flowtesting took on the job of fabricating the new dock with help from Junior Bassmaster Youth Director David Herrera, Junior Bassmaster Jordan McMorris and Bassmaster Jeremiah Striegel. The project took a little over 4 days to complete.

Once the dock fabrication was complete Jerry Stevens of Key Energy Services used a 23 ton crane provided by United Rentals to set the dock in the lake. S & S Flowtesting provided a backhoe to level the ground and construct a path to the walkway from the shore to the new dock. Junior Bassmasters Jordan McMorris and Zack Trujillo along with Monty and Jeremiah Striegel with David Herrera provided labor support during the installation of the Dock.
