

NOTICE: NM BASS Federation Nation \$500 Scholarship

The requirements to apply for and receive a New Mexico B.A.S.S. Chapter Federation Nation Scholarship are set forth below:

1. All scholarship applicants must be a resident of the State of New Mexico or a resident of El Paso County, Texas.
2. Applicants must be attending or applying to attend a degree program as a full time student in an accredited two (2) or four (4) year college or university.
3. Applicants must have a cumulative grade point average of 3.0 or higher and submit a high school, college or university transcript that clearly establishes the cumulative grade point average.
4. Applicants must submit a letter telling why this scholarship is needed and describe the field of study he/she will enter into and why this field of study was chosen.
5. Applicants must submit a paper that addresses a current environmental or conservation concern in the State of New Mexico or El Paso County, Texas. This paper must clearly define the current environmental or conservation concern and provide suggested alternatives to solve or alleviate that concern. Applicants must consent to publication of their paper in Big Mouth, B.A.S.S. Times, or other local publications.
6. Applicants will direct their application materials to the New Mexico B.A.S.S. Chapter Federation Nation by July 28 each year.
7. Applicants must be full time students.
